Our Kids in the Word program continues every Saturday with 25-30 children coming weekly. We have been exploring the character of God through His various names (Immanuel, Jehovah Rapha, El Shaddai). Continue to pray with us that these precious children would come to know Jesus as their Saviour at a young age, destroying the devil's work in their families and community.

Our Youth in Word program consistently has 11-15 youths attending weekly. We are learning what it means to be children of the light and how the enemy wants to destroy their God-given destiny.

On March 31, we planned a games night with our visitors from the Bridge (a Markham community church), Sandra and Mackenzie! It was a great success.

We first studied Ephesians 5:1-14, and what it means to be imitators of Christ through making decisions that please the Lord! Then they participated in fun games and obstacle courses that encouraged teamwork and celebrated each other. It was a great time for them to build community and have fun for His glory.

We are looking forward to more special events like the games night to grow our youth ministry!



Agricultural Program

The fruits of our labour over the several months are reaping great rewards!

We are growing a variety of fruits and vegetables that serve to expand our breakfast program and help families in need. We have planted mango trees, lime trees, orange trees, papaya, plums, pomegranates, plantains, bananas, cherries, cassavas, peas, grapes, pumpkins, and passion fruits. We have 19 hens, 5 roosters and three baby chicks born at Eden's chicken farm! Celebrate the goodness of our Lord with us! We give Him praise and thanksgiving for His faithfulness.

From February 18th until June 24th, we would have hosted eight short-term missionaries! It is wonderful serving alongside our friends and partners in the ministry.

Sometimes short-term mission trips receive a bad reputation if not done correctly! Some people may see it as a humanitarian trip, an opportunity to visit a new country/culture, or an experience to feel good about yourself because you helped someone else.

These are not bad things, but they are NOT what mission trips are really about! It has been my personal experience that a mission trip first starts with God doing a great work in me!
